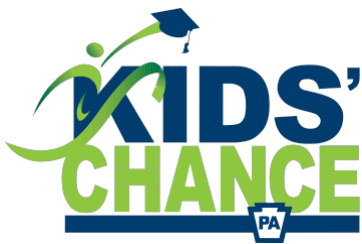
### Kids' Chance of PA by the Numbers
